

What we do:

- We help elect Democrats to every level of office all over the 10th Congressional District, from Waukegan and Zion up north, to Fox Lake out west, down to Mount Prospect and New Trier Township, and everywhere in between.
- We bring people into the political process. We get them involved. Sometimes it's by joining us to rally for a cause or protest a policy. Sometimes it's by helping us recruit and manage our volunteers. Our volunteers have gone on to become staff for candidates and elected officials, and have run for office and won. Many have become leaders of grassroots organizations. We recruit and train volunteers to register voters and provide information on when and where to vote. Our weekly Events List keeps people engaged.
- We host phone banks, organize door-to-door canvasses, design and mail campaign literature, and analyze election data to target key voters.
- Our Election Protection Team of 125 lawyers ensures that every voter who is entitled to vote is allowed to vote.
- Our Tenth Dems University is an ongoing program of speakers that educates voters, inspires more active and effective political volunteers, and teaches skills needed to run for public office.
- Our Let's Talk Politics is a series of moderated discussions
 where Democrats in and around the 10th District talk
 about current issues. These events often feature elected
 officials, candidates, political analysts, and authors.
- Our large internship program gives young people opportunities for civic engagement.
- We help candidates. We recruit, train, and provide advice and support to candidates.
- We believe politics is about more than just elections: it's the process of working together to improve our neighborhoods, state, country, and world. **DEMOCRAT** We offer job interview training and sponsor the Annual Poetry **FOR** and Prose Contest **PRESIDENT** for students. Our offices throughout the district offer a place for residents to meet, talk, and organize.

We get results:

When Tenth Dems was formed in 2003, the northeast corner of Illinois was strongly Republican.

Since then, our all-volunteer organization has helped many Democrats get elected and re-elected to the U.S. Senate and House, the Illinois state legislature, judgeships, and county and local offices.
