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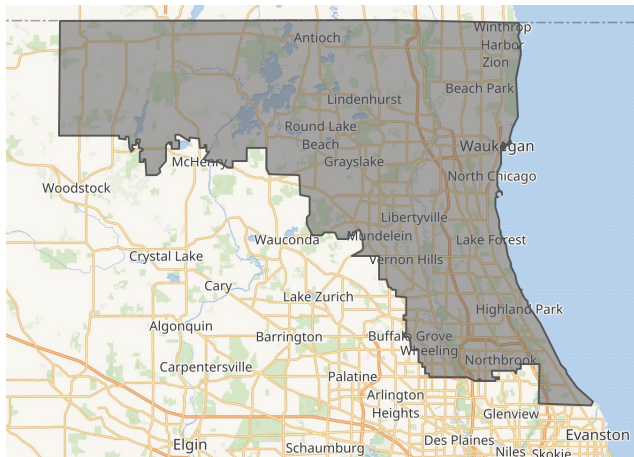

What we do:

- We help elect Democrats to every level of office in and around the 10th Congressional District.
- Our large internship program gives young people opportunities for civic engagement.
- We bring people into the political process. We get them involved. Sometimes it's by joining us to rally for a cause or protest a policy. Our volunteers and interns have gone on to become staff for candidates and elected officials, leaders of organizations, and many have run for office and won. We recruit and train volunteers to register voters and provide information on when and where to vote. Our weekly Events List keeps people engaged.
- We host phone and text banks, organize door-to-door canvasses, design and mail campaign literature, and analyze election data to target key voters.
- Our Election Protection Team of more than 100 lawyers works to make sure every voter who is eligible to vote is allowed to vote, and our attorney-staffed hotline helps answer questions for voters, candidates, and campaign workers.
- Our Tenth Dems University is an ongoing program of speakers that educates voters, inspires more active and effective political volunteers, and teaches skills needed to run for public office.
- Our "Let's Talk Politics" is a series of moderated discussions where Democrats in and around the 10th District talk about current issues. These events often feature elected officials, candidates, and political strategists.
- We're there for our candidates. We recruit, train, and provide advice and support to candidates.

- We believe politics is about more than just elections—it's the process of working together to improve our neighborhoods, state, country, and world. We've provided job interview training and sponsored our Annual Poetry and Prose Contest for students. Our offices throughout the district have offered a place for residents to meet, talk, and organize.

When Tenth Dems was formed in 2003, our northeast corner of Illinois was strongly Republican.

Since then, our all-volunteer organization has helped many Democrats get elected and re-elected to the U.S. Senate and House, the Illinois state legislature, judgeships, and county and local offices.
